



With so many incredible places to visit, Pingtung's coast is unbeatable when it comes to water sports. The conditions are perfect for surfing, standup paddleboarding, kayaking, and sailboating—Pingtung has it all! And it's no secret that every year the area is host to an international surfing competition as well as the Dapeng Bay Marine Festival, bringing in the best competitors from around the world.



1 \ International surfing hotspot /

Surfing

● South Bay Recreational Area, Jialeshui Scenic Area (See appendix for details)

Pingtung has the best waves in all of Taiwan, and with wave conditions in South Bay and Jialeshui being different during the summer and winter, the region is known for having excellent surfing all year round. Every year in October, the best of the best descend on Pingtung to show off their skills at the international surfing competition held in Jialeshui and the area has become an important part of the global surfing scene.

2 \ The best view of the ocean is when you're standing right on it /

Standup Paddleboarding

● Houwan Beach, Liuqiu Island (See appendix for details)

Standup paddleboarding is a blend of surfing and kayaking, and it is typically done on lakes or oceans where the water is flat. A lot of people like it because it's easier to learn than surfing. Pingtung's Houwan Beach and Little Bali Rock have perfect paddleboarding conditions with calm waves, beautiful beaches, and clear water. Get a new perspective on the ocean and spend the day exploring its wonders from atop a paddleboard.



3 \ Get in on the kayak trend /

Kayaking

● Houwan Beach, Liuqiu Island (See appendix for details)

Kayaking is really popular in Pingtung right now, and it's not hard to see why. The calm waters and gorgeous coastlines of Houwan Beach and Liuqiu Island are perfect for self-propelled water sports. For a special treat, go out during sunrise or sunset and have an unforgettable experience gazing at the colorful corals and vibrant sea life through the crystal-clear water.

The liveliest time of year is during the annual Dapeng Bay Marine Festival when competitors from all over the world come to take part. Let's Hit the Beach

South Bay is one of Kenting's most popular beaches, with warm waters providing excellent surfing all year round. This is why the area attracts surfers from across the world. A trip to Kenting wouldn't be complete without seeing the sunset from Guanshan or visiting Maobitou reef. It's surfing heaven.



5 \ Kenting's most popular beach /

South Bay

- No. 223, Nanwan Rd., Nanwan Vil., Hengchun Township, Pingtung County
- Hours of Operation: 24/7



South Bay attracts tourists to its relaxing beaches all year long. The location is also a surfing hotspot, with calm waves throughout the year that are perfect for beginners. But in the summer, during typhoon season, it's not uncommon to see the monster waves that the pros just can't get enough of.



6 \ Food and fun at Houbi Lake port /

Houbi Lake

- No. 79-43, Daguang Rd., Daguang Vil., Hengchun Township, Pingtung County
- Hours of Operation: 24/7

Houbi Lake is the biggest port in all of Hengchun Township, and it is home to both the local fishery and leisure sailing crowd. This is where you'll find the Eyai Sailing Club, where you can take your pick of sailboat, speedboat, or yacht – whichever suits your style. For those who want to get closer to the action, the area also has some of the best snorkeling and parasailing around.

7 \ Hengchun's world renowned, must-see sunset /

Guanshan Sunset

- No. 9-8, Binlang Rd., Hengchun Township, Pingtung County
- 1:30pm – 5:30pm, weekends 10:00am – 5:30pm

Guanshan is a coral reef that has been lifted out of the water to form a plateau, providing a breathtaking view of the ocean that stretches out as far as the eye can see. The area has been famous for its sunsets even since the Qing Dynasty, and in 2013 was reported by CNN as one of 12 superb sunset spots around the world. With so much international recognition, its little wonder people come from so far just to see it for themselves.



8 \ The cutest cape in Taiwan /

Maobitou Park

- No. 100, Xiaquan Rd., Hengchun Township, Pingtung County
- 8:00am – 5:00pm

Shaped like a cat crouching in the water, Maobitou is easily one of the cutest natural attractions in Taiwan. Take a walk along Maobitou Park's seaside trail and see the intricate folds in the coastal reef carved by the relentless ocean waves, which have sculpted the entire landscape into an incredible vista of smooth pockmarks, deep grooves, and dramatic spires. The greatest artists have nothing on mother nature.



Water Sport Wonderland

The oceans around Pingtung are truly unique, providing the perfect setting for a wide variety of water sports. Go snorkeling and get up close and personal with nature or ride a semi-submersible and get a window into the underwater world. For the eco-conscious traveler, standup paddleboarding or kayaking are some of the best ways to experience the sea. Explorers of all levels can find what they're looking for.




9 \ One-on-one intro to snorkeling /

Wanli Dong

- No. 14-3, Wanli Rd., Hengchun Township, Pingtung County

- 8:30am – 5:00pm

Located between Shihjhu and Syunguangzui, Wanli Dong is a 1-kilometer stretch of coastline bursting with gorgeous underwater features and is one of the most popular places for snorkeling in Kenting National Park. Go on a one-on-one guided tour from the Wanlitong Snorkeling Center to see all the ocean has to offer with a range of tours of varying difficulty.



10 \ Houwan marine conservation /

Houwan

Houwan Beach is known for having crystal-clear water with high visibility, white coral reefs, sandy beaches strewn with smooth skipping stones, and a calm surface that can become still as glass. In order to protect this precious natural beauty, the locals have come up with a number of eco-tourism packages, including tours of Gueishan Trail and the tidal flats, and a cooking experience using tofu and sea salt. Visitors can also take a look around the ocean on a standup paddleboard or kayak.



11 \ Get a peek of hidden / underwater worlds /

Hongchaikeng

Just below the barrier formed by the West Hengchun Hill, the waters of the Hongchaikeng Fishing Port are calm and bursting with ocean life. People come here for the snorkeling, and it has some of the best in Taiwan. But you don't even have to get wet to see the magical underwater world. Take a ride on the specially built semi-submersible or try the glass-bottomed boat to see the sights without even changing into your bathing suit.



12 \ Radiant sunsets and bleached white sand /

White Sand Bay

- No. 8, Baisha Rd., Hengchun Township, Pingtung County
- 08-886-1321 (Kenting National Park Headquarters)
- Hours of Operation: 24/7



Looking down on White Sand Bay from Guanshan above, you'll notice not just the cobalt blue ocean, but also the bleached white sand of the crescent-shaped beach glittering in the sun. The beach has long been a favorite of visitors to Kenting, but since being featured in the film "Cape No. 7" its popularity has only increased. The dramatic sunset views are fitting for the big screen and for your own romantic adventures.



Explore the Secrets of Liuqiu

#TropicalForests #VibrantReefs #SikaDeerPark

Once an underwater coral reef, over the eons Liuqiu Island has been lifted out of the sea and carved by the ocean into its present-day shape. Separated from the rest of the world, the island has a pristine coastline, mysterious tropical woodlands, intricately carved reefs, and a conservation area for Taiwan's sika deer, each with its own story just waiting for you to discover.



13 \ Mother nature's floral masterpiece /

Flower Vase Rock

- Flower Vase Rock, Liuqiu Township, Pingtung County

You can't miss the unique shape of Flower Vase Rock as you take the ferry over to Liuqiu Island. The rock is big on top and thin down below, and with its crown of flowers you can see how it gets its name. All around Flower Vase Rock are the magnificently folded and crumpled lines of the fringing reef—a testament to the power of the movement of the Earth's crust.




14 \ Reefs of all shapes and sizes /

Houshi Fringing Reef

- Houshi Fringing Reef, Liuqiu Township, Pingtung County

Nestled between Dafu Fishing Harbor and HaiTzuKuo are reefs that have been worn into all manner of intricate shapes by the relentless push and pull of the ocean waves. There's "Indian Rock" wearing its Native American feathered headdress, "Guanyin Rock" lost in deep contemplation, and "Skirt Reef" that flows out like a ballerina's tutu. Long ago, the pockmarks in the reefs were used by the locals as salt jars for drying salt.



15 \ Immerse yourself in lush tropical jungle /

Wild Boar Trench Trail

- No. 60, Huandao Rd., Liuqiu Township, Pingtung County
- April - Oct. 7:00am - 6:00pm, Nov. - March 7:30am - 5:00pm



Wild Boar Trench Trail is a winding path that skirts around sheer cliffs and craggy mountain rocks inlaid with fossilized corals and seashells—remnants of the land's past life as an underwater habitat. As you make your way through the mountain valley, you'll be enveloped by a corridor of lush tropical vegetation growing along the limestone of the ancient coral reef. The trail is dear to the hearts of the locals and anyone you meet is sure to have many good stories to tell of their times walking in its wilderness.

16 \ The sika deer of Liuqiu Island /

Wonderland of Deer

Liuqiu Island is famous for being a haven for sea turtles, but its newest attraction is Wonderland of Deer, where visitors can come to feed and learn about deer of all kinds, including the iconic sika deer. Take a guided tour and get the know what makes each group of deer so special and why it's so important to protect our environment and the animals that live there.



Head for the Hills

#HikerTrainingGround #BreathtakingMountainTrails

There are 10 breathtaking hiking trails running between northern Pingtung's Weiliao Mountain and Kenting National Park to the south that should be on everyone's bucket list. The trails range in difficulty from an easy jaunt all the way up to professional mountaineering. The path from sea to sky will take you through some of the best of Pingtung's cultural, ecological, and historical landmarks.



17 \ A love of nature starts here /

Family-friendly nature walks

● Shaungliu Forest Recreation Area Hiking Trails, Liangshan Waterfall Trail, Alangyi Old Trail, Gueishan Trail (See appendix for details)

Pingtung has 10 famously beautiful hiking trails, including the Shaungliu Forest Recreation Area Hiking Trails that run along Fenggang River, Liangshan Waterfall Trail in the Maolin National Scenic Area, the Alangyi Old Trail that traces a path along the coast between Daren and Mudan Townships, and Gueishan Trail next to the National Museum of Marine Biology & Aquarium. These light nature walks are fun for the whole family and are sure to inspire a love of nature in even the youngest little adventurer.



18 \ Trace a line through history's / crucial moments /

Historic trails

● Jinshueiyng National Trail, Shimenshan Trail (See appendix for details)

Shimenshan Trail, located in Mudan Township, is important to Taiwan's history because it runs close to where the Mudan Incident occurred, which sparked Japan's assault on southern Taiwan. Jinshueiyng National Trail, which weaves through a lush broad-leaved forest, takes you right across the mountain range from Pingtung to Taitung and is the longest cross-mountain historic trail in Taiwan. Along the way, you'll encounter old artifacts left behind by the peoples that used to live here. The area is even listed as one of Taiwan's protected cultural assets.



19 \ Want to tackle Taiwan's tallest / mountains? Start here /

Hikers' training ground

● Weiliao Mountain Trail, Lilongshan Trail (See appendix for details)



For those who want a bit of a challenge, Weiliao Mountain Trail and Lilongshan Trail, which are on the list of Taiwan's 100-tallest mountains, are the perfect testing ground. Weiliao Mountain Trail is located at the border between Sandimen Township and Maolin District in Kaohsiung City. The second half of the hike is so steep that ropes are provided to help people scramble up the slope and it's seen as a great way for hikers to improve their fitness. Lilongshan Trail wends its way along mountain cliffs so high and soaring that it feels as if you're walking through a crowd of giants.

20 \ The guardians of the Pingtung Plain /

Dawu Mountain Trails

● North Dawu Mountain Trail, South Dawu Mountain Trail (See appendix for details)



North Dawu Mountain Trail is a challenging 9-km hike that takes you from the old mountain entrance to a height of 1549 meters at the summit. The mountain, called Meli-miligang (fantastically beautiful) in the language of the local Paiwan Indigenous peoples, has rich biodiversity, and the South Dawu Mountain Trail is part of the Dawushan Nature Reserve. The policy of protecting the forest by not fixing the roads after they collapse means that visitors can only enter the area with a professional guide.



I Want to Ride My Bicycle

For people who like the beach and the woods, there are three routes in Pingtung's color-coded bike path system to choose from: a tour around Dapeng Bay, an easy ride along the Linbian River, and an adventure in a mountain forest. All three feature historic sites, rural towns, artist villages, and more mountain scenery and ocean vistas than you can shake a stick at.



21 \ Ride along the oceanside /

Dapeng Bay Bike Path

- Starting point: Dapeng Bay Bridge, Donggang Township, Pingtung County
- 08-833-8100 (Dapeng Bay National Scenic Area)

The Dapeng Bay bike path is a 32-kilometer route taking you past fishponds and beaches to some of Pingtung's most stunning scenery. First, you'll reach the Qifeng Wetlands with so much coastal vegetation it looks as if there's a forest growing right on top of the ocean. Next, in Sunset Bay, you can watch the waters rushing out of the canal and into the ocean. Further along, when you get to the Qingzhou Coastal Recreation Area, you can stop for a quick beach volleyball game. When you arrive at Dapeng Bay Marina, you can trade your bike in for a boat and go out to see Oyster Shell Island, which, as its name suggests, is made almost entirely out of oyster shells!



22 \ Over 250km of stunning ocean views /

Pingtung Sec., Taiwan Cycle Route No.1

- Starting point: No. 18, Chuyun Rd., Fangliao Vil., Fangliao Township, Pingtung County

The purple line in Pingtung's color-coded bike path system is the Pingtung section of Taiwan Cycle Route No. 1. It is a long and challenging ride that starts at Fangliao Station and switches between ocean and mountain for over 250 kilometers before ending at the Hengchun Bus Station. But with so many incredible sights along the way, including Sail Rock, Eluanbi Lighthouse, and Longpan Park, you'll find yourself at the end of the line before you know it!



23 \ An easy tour of Taiwan's unique cultural assets /

Seaside Bike Path

- Starting point: No. 169, Datan Rd., Donggang Township, Pingtung County



The yellow line in Pingtung's color-coded bike path system crosses over the Linbian River through Linbian, Jiadong, and Fangliao Townships. These communities have an understated, reserved beauty that comes from their cultural development along the seaside. Go slowly along the route, take in the rich cultural history of the area, and see the success of fishing village regeneration and artistic revitalization projects in the Guang Tsai Wetlands and at Fangliao Station.

24 \ Immerse yourself in local indigenous culture /

Tree-lined Bike Path

- Starting point: No. 251, Chenggong Rd., Neipu Township, Pingtung County



The mountain forest bike trail, which is designated as the green line in Pingtung's color-coded bike path system, is widely considered to be the most challenging. Starting in Gaoshu Township, you will wind your way through Majia, Taiwu, and Xinpi Townships all under the watchful gaze of Dawu Mountain. Ride deep into the local Indigenous lands of the Rinari Tribe, explore the Liangshan Recreational Area, and marvel at the sight of Danlin Suspension Bridge. Don't forget to take a rest at Pingtung Coffee Park along the way to charge up with a cup of locally grown coffee.



A Bicycle Route to Challenge Both Body and Mind

#VillageTour #PingtungByBike

The best way to get to know Pingtung is to roam through its towns and villages by bicycle. To help visitors find the bike path that best suits their interests, Pingtung's bicycle routes have been organized into seven color-coded options, each leading to wonderful surprises in the mountains or along the seaside where you'll learn about the area's former sugar and fishing industries. Exploring Pingtung by bike, you'll see the memories of its past and the beauty of its present.



25 \ The first national bike path in Taiwan /

National Bike Path

● Starting point: Houzhuang Rd. at the Jiuru Interchange, Jiuru Township, Pingtung County

The red line in Pingtung's color-coded bike path system is the national bike path. The route goes along the road under the overpasses of the Southern Second Highway, protecting the rider from any wind or rain. The national bike path passes through some of Pingtung's most important cultural and industrial landmarks, such as Liudui Hakka Cultural Park in Neipu Township, Orchid Fern Bicycle Lane, and the natural landscapes of Linluo Wetland Park. It's an easy-riding path that's suitable for riders of all ages.

26 \ Tour the churches along the old Taiwan Sugar railways /

TaiSugar Railway Bike Path

● Starting point: No. 1, Afulu'an Rd., 5th Neighborhood, Taiwu Vil., Taiwu Township, Pingtung County (In front of Taiwu Elementary School)



The old railway lines of the Taiwan Sugar Co. have been revitalized into a 30.61-kilometer-long bike path with lots to see along the way. You can make a tour of the area's old churches by first visiting Wanjin Catholic Basilica, then moving on to Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church, before arriving at Yuhuan Catholic Church. Other options include cocoa and coffee plantations, fishing villages, wetlands, and of course the influential sugar industry of days gone by.

27 \ Easy riding through rural Pingtung /

Cross-island Routes

● Starting point: Huilun Rd., Wandan Township, Pingtung County/Linluo Wetland Park, Linluo Township, Pingtung County



The orange lines in Pingtung's color-coded bike path system are the cross-island routes. There is the east-west route running from Linluo to Neipu, and the north-south route running between Wandan and Chaozhou. Both paths take you through rural streets and country fields, showing you a mix of people, culture, landscapes, and industry for a deep dive into the local lifestyle.

28 \ Love trains? Then indigo is for you /

Railway Bike Path

● Starting point: No. 62, Gongyong Rd., Pingtung City, Pingtung County (Pingtung Station)



The indigo lines in Pingtung's color-coded bike path system are the railway bike routes. These paths run from one train station to the next, connecting Pingtung City with Linluo, Zhutian, and Chaozhou Townships. The 22.85-kilometer route mixes public art with local Hakka culture. As the bike path crosses over with the railway tracks, you'll be sure to encounter the awesome sight and sounds of the trains as they chug along their tracks.
